

GOVT. MIZO HIGH SCHOOL

Govt. Mizo High School has the distinction of being the first ever High School in Mizoram. Before this, only few meritorious students were sent outside Mizoram on Government scholarship for further studies. The Welsh Missionaries as well as the few educated Mizos at the time felt the great need and demand for High School. They fervently tried various means for the establishment of High School. This great dream came to be realised when Mr A. MacDonald ICS, became the new Superintendent of the then Lushai hills in 1943. He not only gave his permission but initiated the opening of the High school. Mizo High School was thus started in February 1944 at the Young Lushai Association (YLA) hall, Mission veng with 56 students in class VIII. The name Mizo High School was unanimously decided to represent all the Mizo students who had for so long ardently wished to continue their education on their own soil.



LOCATION

The School shifted to this present location in 1945. At that time, the area was a big tea estate owned by the First Battalion, Assam Rifles. Mr A MacDonald bought the whole land as big as 80 bighas for the purpose of the high school. The location of the school is duly named MacDonald Hill to honour the benefactor.

CAMPUS

The School is located in the heart of Aizawl city, easily accessible by transport or on foot, perched on a hill undisturbed by the hustle and bustle of the city. The campus facilities include a big L-Shaped three storied RCC building-well ventilated and spacious classrooms with one smart-classroom. The original Assam type School building still stands today and is used for Library, Science labs, Art room, WE room and NCC store and office room. There is a big School hall with three Badminton courts that can also be used for playing other games. The School also boasts of a big and famous playground fondly known by all as 'High Field'. The campus also hosts a big ground where more than 700 students come together for Morning Assembly.



MANAGEMENT

Mizo High School was placed under the management and control of the Missionaries in Aizawl. The missionaries and their wives taught on voluntary basis. Rev JM Loyd became the first Headmaster in 1945. Class-VIII was opened that year and the enrollment reached 76. The first batch of 25 students appeared for Matriculation



Examination under Assam Board and 20 students (80%) came out successful. Since its establishment in 1944, Mizo High School has been blessed and boasts of many excellent and notable alumnus who have served in high bureaucratic posts both in the state and central governments. It is still the biggest government High school in Mizoram till date with an enrollment of about 800 students. The Government took over the management of the school in 1950 and the name of the school changed to **Govt Mizo High School**.



EXTRA CURRICULARS AND OTHER FACILITIES:

School House System - Students are grouped into different houses - to create healthy competitions and to encourage them to excel in various fields. House captains and assistants are appointed for each house and they take on the various activities on the advice of the teacher-in-charge. Inter-house competitions are held from time to time.

National Cadet Corps (NCC) :

NCC was started in the School in 1953, which helped many students secure 'A' certificates in Junior Division. Students are encouraged to get enrolled in NCC. The first school NCC Pipe Band in



Mizoram was also started in 2000. They have performed numerous times in state official functions and they have been selected to perform at the Republic Day Celebrations in New Delhi for a number of years since 2012. Now we offer three wings to the students under NCC, where the students can enroll in any one of them -

1. NCC Army
2. NCC Air wing
3. NCC Pipe Band

Student Police Cadet- With the introduction of Student Police Cadet among the School going children, the School is one of the few Schools which offers Student Police Cadet for the Students. It is opened to students who are interested, to enroll themselves under police cadet.



Arts Club


The School has an Arts club to develop the skills and talents of young students. Many of the students have performed in the state competition, and outside of Mizoram as well. Those students who are willing to join this arts club can be enrolled when the new session starts.

Students Christian Endeavour (Zirlai Kristian Beihram Pawl)

Mizo High School gives great priority to the pupils' spiritual, moral, and emotional well-being. A religious congregation called 'Zirlai Kristian Beihram Pawl' has been going on for many years for those who wish to take active part in evangelical ministry. The religious meeting is held twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays for those who wish to attend.

Guidance & Counselling

The school provides career guidance programme with Resource Persons. Supported by a team of counsellors and special educators the school guides to students any sort of psychological/ emotional disturbances during school hours. Whenever needed parents are also counselled to help them cope with the pressure they face.



Excursion & Study Tour

The School organizes excursion, study tour and field trip for meritorious and deserving students at various places depending on financial availability.

Academics

The School caters to two classes - IX and X. Class IX has eight sections and can accommodate more than 400 hundred while class-X has five sections which can enroll about 300 students. The Academic Year (session) begins in April and ends in Feb-March. Our school is affiliated to Mizoram Board of School Education (MBSE) and the curriculum and Textbooks are as prescribed by the Board. for class IX & X.

Subject include - MLL, English, Science, Mathematics, Social Science, Hindi and Work experience



Admission

Admission is opened in the month of March and given to new students in class IX only. Admission form and Prospectus are given out from the School Office to those students who seek admission. Admission is given through Admission test and interview. Selection of students is done with the criteria framed by the School.

Aims

Our School aims to grow our students into productive citizens, who can use their knowledge, talents, and learned skills to sustain themselves and help others, and to be abiding citizens. No discrimination among the students is allowed in respect to caste, religion, sex, family background and social status etc.





Other Informations

Uniforms :

Students should come to school with proper and clean school uniforms. Every student is expected to look smart and clean in their school dress. School uniforms should be neat and tidy, and shoes should be well polished. However students may be allowed to sit in the class without proper school uniform if and when written permission is obtained from the school authority.

1. Skirts : Black terry cotton skirts.

Only pleated skirts should be worn for school uniforms. Skirts must cover from the navel down to the knee. The size of pleats should be one inch and the size of hem two inches.

2. Pants/Trousers : Black terry cotton pants/trousers and it should not be worn at low waist. No tight fitting and extreme narrow bottom pants are not allowed.

3. Shirts : White plain shirt with short sleeves.

4. Shoes : Plain black Bata/Liberty shoes for boys and girls.

5. Socks : Black plain socks, upto knee bend for girls and upto calf for boys.

6. Belt : Black and white striped belt

7. T-Shirt : School T-Shirt on Tuesday and Friday.

**Other than the compulsory School uniforms, the students can wear pre-scribed pull-over, muffler, sweater and blazer.*

For the convenience of the students and consistency, all uniform and study materials will be made available in the School.

Examination

The School is affiliated to MBSE and follows the School curriculum prescribed by the Board. Under the Board, we followed Integrated Evaluation system where we have two terminal examinations with two internal assessments test in between each term. And at the end of the session the School has Promotion examination covering all the syllabus for the current year. Promotion is granted on the basis of the promotion examination marks and internal marks secured by the student.





The institution brings out the capacity of the students in games and sports and helps them to do their best in their own disciplines. The institution has won over all championship for eight consecutive years i.e: 2011-2018 in Aizawl District Secondary School Games which is a record.



RESTRICTIONS

- ✎ Bleaching and colouring of hair for boys and girls.

- ✎ Applying of hair gel.
- ✎ Tattoos and body markings.
- ✎ Body piercing and making artificial moles on any part of the body.
- ✎ Use of cosmetics and ornaments.
- ✎ Smoking, use of drugs or intoxicating substances.
- ✎ Any form of Gambling.
- ✎ Disfiguring or damaging school property.
- ✎ Use of violence in any form Setting up of organisation other than the organisation set up by the school authority.
- ✎ Obscene objects.
- ✎ Any other character or behaviour which may be deemed as disrespect to their fellow students and teachers.
- ✎ Bringing of Mobile phones and electronic Gadgets in the school.
- ✎ Medicines without permission of the school authority.





Attendance

Every student should maintain good attendance.

Students are not allowed to leave the school during school hour without prior permission from the School authority.

If any student is absent, their parents/Guardians must report the matter to the class Teacher in person within three days from the day of absence.

Absence for five or more consecutive days without informing the school authority may amount to striking off the student's name from the roll.

No leave letter or verbal information through telephone shall be entertained.

Leave application by NGO, Church bodies etc regarding camps, Sports, Social work may not be considered
